

Dear Members:

We have reserved a block of rooms at the Nassau Inn in Princeton (room rates and phone number below), but have recently learned that our block has filled. In addition, we've been informed by the Nassau Inn that the remainder of the hotel is sold out for the night of Friday, May 7th. However, the hotel management has informed us that the reason for the sell-out is because they are holding blocks of rooms for two other conferences, who may or may not fill up their block. They are encouraging people who try to make a reservation but are told Friday is not available to ask to be put on a waiting list. They say there is a very good chance the list will clear. You should plan to make your hotel arrangements right away, so that, in the event there is a wait list, your name will appear at the top of the list.

The Nassau Inn is the closest hotel to the conference site, so we encourage you to try to reserve your room there first. As a backup, below is a list of other area hotels in case you are unable to reserve space at the Nassau.
