I'm pleased to announce that registration is now open for this year's annual meeting, which will be held on Friday and Saturday, June 9-10, 2023, at Boston University School of Law, located at 765 Commonwealth Avenue, Boston, MA.

The conference sessions will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Friday (following a breakfast from 8:00-9:00 a.m.) and conclude by about 3:45 p.m. on Saturday. There will be a keynote address by Louis Kaplow, Recipient of the 2022 Ronald H. Coase Award, on Friday at 1:00 p.m., with an introduction by Roberta Romano. Cocktails and dinner will be held on Friday evening, with a keynote address by the Association's incoming president, James R. Hines, Jr. Saturday will wrap up with a reception starting around 5:00 p.m.

The Association is happy to announce a slight reduction in the registration fee. The registration fee will be \$350.00 (\$130.00 for students), which includes all meals and social functions during the conference. **The early registration deadline is Sunday, May 28, 2023. We will charge a late fee for on-site registration or registrations received after Sunday, May 28<sup>th</sup>, and no refunds will be given after that date.** All attendees must register for the meeting (including paper presenters). Before registering, you will also need to become an ALEA member who has paid this year's membership fees. Currently, masking is optional on BU's campus. Proof of vaccination will not be required.

**LODGING:** The Association has reserved a block of rooms at Hotel Commonwealth, which is walking distance to BU Law, where all sessions will be held.
