The hotels in Hyde Park tend to book up fast, so we recommend making your reservations early!

The closest hotel is [The Study](#), which is directly adjacent to the [Rubenstein Forum](#) where the conference will be held. **[UPDATED INFORMATION]**: Our limited ALEA Block at The Study has sold out, although you can check this link just in case we are able to secure more rooms or in case there are cancellations: [ALEA Block](#). Alternatively, you can call 773-643-1600, press “1” for reservations, and ask for the ALEA Block or any other currently available booking options. There may be some availability through [The Study’s general booking channel](#) or third party booking services, which have sometimes showed more availability than The Study’s own website.

Nearby in Hyde Park:

[The Sophy](#) (1.2 miles away). Currently showing \$399 per night for the conference dates (with discounted AAA and government rates)

[Hyatt Place](#) **[UPDATED INFORMATION]**: (1.4 miles away). We have secured a small block of rooms at a discounted ALEA rate of \$255/night (plus taxes). Rooms outside of that block are currently listed at a standard rate of \$346 per night for the conference dates / \$319 for Hyatt members / various other discounted rates, so if you are interested in staying at the Hyatt, please make your reservations as soon as possible so that you might obtain that special ALEA rate.
